**Roberts' Rules of Meeting Order**  
For Fair and Orderly Meetings & Conventions

The following rules will be in effect during the Open Forum:

- The Open Forum is the homeowner's time to ask questions, make statements, etc.
- Roberts Rules of Order will prevail, i.e., unruly speakers lose their right to be heard and the Board has the right to close the Open Forum and begin the business meeting or adjourn the meeting.
- Also in keeping with Roberts Rules of Order, all inquires made during the Open Forum are addressed to the meeting chairperson, i.e., the Board President.
- Due to the time frame and number of homeowners that wish to speak, we may limit the amount of time for each homeowner to 3 minutes.
- Once the BOD business meeting begins, there will be no further opportunity to voice comments/questions from the floor; however, if the business meeting ends before 9 p.m., we can reopen the floor to the floor (keeping in mind that we must vacate the facility by 9 p.m.).
- All suggestions/comments made by the homeowners at the Open Forum will be taken under advisement by the Board.
